Juneteenth (June 19) honors truth, freedom, and the ongoing fight for equity. On June 19, 1865 more than two years after the Emancipation Proclamation enslaved African Americans in Galveston, Texas were finally informed of their freedom. It's a moment of reckoning, remembrance, and celebration.
